Safety / Compliance Tips

- General places of employment, passageways, storerooms, and service rooms shall be kept clean and orderly.
- Adequate aisles and passageways must be maintained in all work areas.
- Welding hoses and electric conductors must be elevated over or placed under the walkway or working surfaces or be covered by adequate crossover planks.
- All immediate working areas must be kept reasonably free of debris.
- Construction material and supplies must be stacked as not to present a hazard to workers.
- Slippery conditions must be eliminated as they occur.
- Means of egress must be maintained at all times to all exits and to all fire-alarm boxes or fire-extinguishing equipment.
- Oils, paints thinners, solvents, waste, rags, or other flammable substances must be kept in fire-resistant covered containers when not in use.
- Rest rooms must be maintained in a neat and sanitary condition.
- Break rooms and lunch rooms must be maintained in a neat and sanitary condition.
