

## 2008 SAFETY AWARD PROGRAM

The American Equity Underwriters, Inc. (AEU) is pleased to announce the 2008 Safety Award program criteria. The program is open to all ALMA members and is based on 2008 safety performance. To participate, ALMA members must send the man-hour totals from their OSHA Form 300A for 2008 to AEU by May 30, 2009. Winners will be announced during the 2009 ALMA Conference, July 9 - 12, 2009.

The program will identify ALMA members with the lowest frequency of injury cases. It will give each member an opportunity to measure their safety performance against companies of similar size in the shipyard and marine cargo handling industries.

AEU would like to thank the members of the AEU Safety Committee for their comments and suggestions about the program.

There will be two categories:

1. Shipyards
2. Marine Cargo Handling

Both categories will have three winners, based on the man-hour groups below.

- a. 100,000 – 500,000 man-hours annually
- b. 500,000 – 2,000,000 man-hours annually
- c. 2,000,000 and above man-hours annually

### Guidelines

1. For the purpose of this program, man-hours submitted to AEU should be direct employee man-hours during 2008. Do not include subcontract labor hours.
2. The term of the program is January 1, 2008 to December 31, 2008.
