

PENALTIES FOR NON-REPORTING PER THE USL&H ACT

LS-202, First Report of Injury must be filed by the employer within 10 days—Penalty for failure to do so up to \$22,957 per occurrence [33 U.S.C section 930(a)]

Late payment of compensation - 10% [33 U.S.C. section 914(e)]

Late payment of compensation under an Order - 20% [33 U.S.C. section 914(f)]

Failure to insure - Up to \$10,000 [33 U.S.C. section 938(a)]
