STEP 3 SUBMIT

As of July 21, 2017, you only need to submit the LS-202 form to AEU (as soon as possible but no later than seven days following the accident).

AEU will then submit that form directly to the Department of Labor the following business day.

Please refer to your State Workers' Compensation Notice for specific state rules.

State laws can vary. Please check with your AEU Claims Specialist for First Report of Injury filing instructions.
