

Checklist: Working the Strike Zone



Injuries from being struck by objects handled by others are preventable. Adequate planning and evaluation can help control the hazards created by objects being handled.

The following preventive actions are recommended to reduce struck-by objects handled by

others at a workplace:
Follow the safety instructions given in JSA or safe work planning meeting and the standard operating procedures (SOP)
Train personnel that work in or around the strike zone of objects handled by others' work operations
Strict supervision, monitoring and controlling objects handled by others' work activities
Regular safety inspections of loads and observations of work operations
Use of appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) by the workers (e.g., reflective vests)
Marking all hazardous areas utilizing notices and signs
Stacking or securing loads properly
Establishing a strike zone for objects handled by others work activities
